Proverbs (From VOA Special English: Words and their stories)

A proverb is a <u>short</u>, well known saying that expresses a common truth or belief. Proverbs are found in most cultures and are often <u>very</u> old.

Benjamin Franklin <u>was</u> famous for his proverbs. Franklin lived in <u>the</u> seventeen hundreds. He was a leader of the American Revolution against <u>English</u> rule. He was also a scientist, inventor and writer.



Franklin published a <u>book</u> called "Poor Richard's

Almanac." He included <u>many</u> proverbs that he had heard or created.

Some of them are still used <u>today</u>. Like this one: "Early to bed and early to rise makes a man <u>healthy</u>, wealthy and wise."

Franklin is also remembered for <u>other</u> proverbs like, "A penny saved is a penny earned." This means that <u>money</u> should not be wasted.

Here are other <u>examples</u> of proverbs that Americans use. The first ones <u>are</u> about love. Some people say, **"All is fair in love and war."** They mean that anything <u>you</u> do in a relationship or in battle is acceptable.

Another <u>proverb</u> about love is, "Absence makes the heart grow fonder." This means you <u>love</u> someone even more when he or she is far away. But other <u>people</u> say, "Out of sight, out of mind." You may not even think <u>about</u> that person when he or she is not with you. Which of these proverbs do you <u>think</u> is most true?

Another proverb says "Love is blind." In other <u>words</u>, when you are in love with someone, you may refuse to see anything bad about that person.

Here is another <u>popular</u> saying about love: "The way to a man's heart is through his stomach." Some people <u>believe</u> that a woman can win a man's love if she prepares his <u>favorite</u> foods.

Some people are only interested in having a relationship with someone who is very good-looking. You might tell <u>them</u> that "Beauty is only skin deep." Your girlfriend may be lovely to look at, but she may also have some <u>bad</u> qualities. Or the opposite may be <u>true</u>. Your boyfriend is a wonderful person, but not good-looking. So what a person looks like is not really <u>important</u>.

Another <u>proverb</u> is true in love and war or other situations: "**Actions** speak louder than words." It means that what you <u>do</u> is more important than what you say.

Sadly, we have no more <u>time</u>. So we must say, "All good things must come to an end."
